Note: Pasadena City College is the only local community college that begins its Spring semester in the first week of January. By beginning on January 7, PCC begins between 4 and 6 weeks before the six other area colleges. This early start creates a conflict with all the other local colleges' Winter Intersession. Because of the early start, PCC ends about a month before other colleges. Thus, part time faculty who wish to teach Summer at PCC will have a four to six week overlap with classes at the other colleges. Essentially, any part time faculty member who currently teaches at PCC will have to choose between teaching at PCC or teaching at one or more of the other colleges. Part time faculty can't do both. The part time faculty member will not be able to resolve such a long overlap.

This also creates great difficulty for students who want to take classes at PCC.
